

## CHARTLET FOR THE DEBEN ENTRANCE 2019

Imray's chartlet for the Deben entrance follows on the next page of this PDF. It was drawn from a Trinity House survey carried out in March 2019, results handed to Imray specifically to produce this chartlet for us.

Bearing lines shown on the chartlet give bearings from one buoy to the next on entry to help you spot them in poor visibility, and do not necessarily mark the route with the best water.

Skippers are advised as ever to watch out for tidal set across the entrance (NE to SW on the flood tide) and to take extra care to stay on track as the entrance channel is very narrow.

Skippers needing any further advice on the spot can call ECP's local Honorary Port Pilot, and Deben Harbourmaster, John White, either on VHF Ch 08 callsign 'Odd Times', or by phone on 07803 476621

As ever, this entrance remains subject to change during periods of strong onshore winds, and the advice given here and indeed the chartlet may have to be updated during the course of the summer.

Below is an aerial shot of the entrance taken by an ECP reader on 22nd April near LWS. John White is in his boat tied up to the Mid Knoll buoy and reported less than 0.7m between the red buoys.

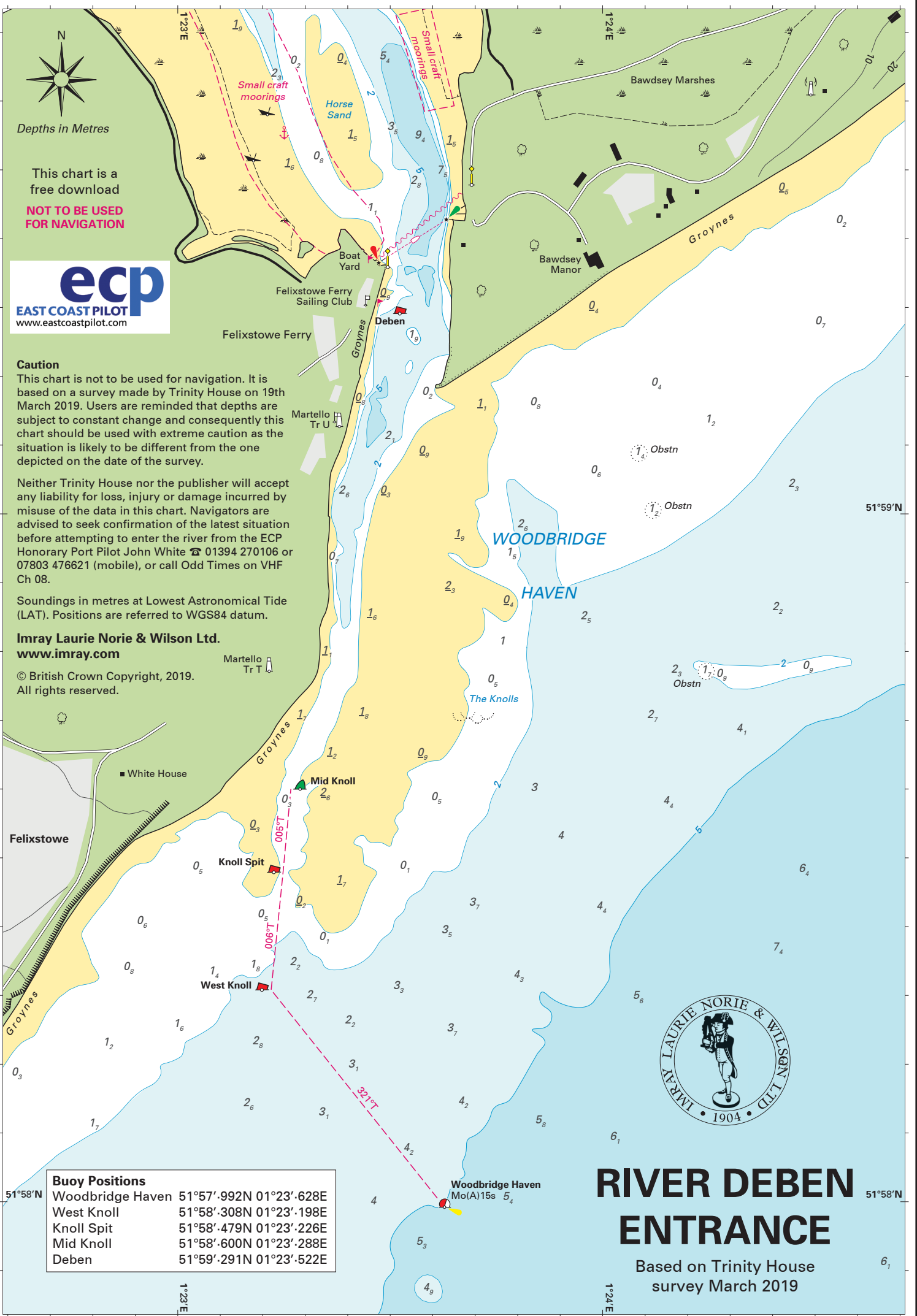
